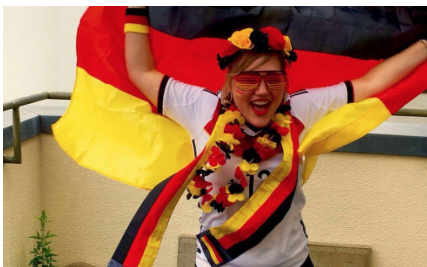
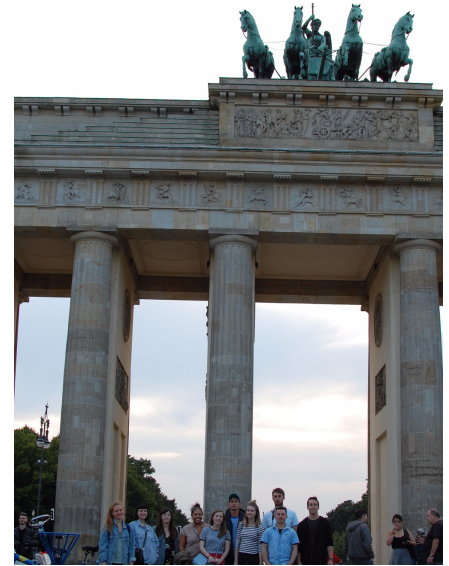


# Nomaden Berlin

## What our community offers

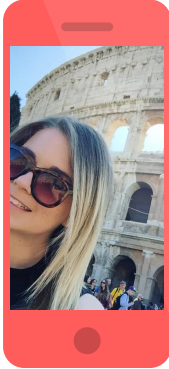

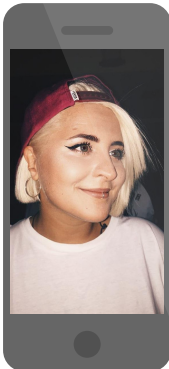

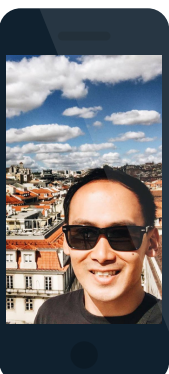

The bureaucracy in Berlin is notoriously tricky. The first step is to register your address (anmeldung) in Berlin, a process that takes some expats a number of months to complete. With Nomaden Berlin, we book your appointments in advance, complete your paperwork and accompany you to the appointment, taking all the stress away in the process. We register you in the first week, allowing you to get your tax number, set up a bank account and begin the visa process. We will also provide ongoing administrative and visa support and advice, to ensure you quickly complete all the steps to becoming a fully-fledged Berliner.

Don't speak German? No problem, our language school partner will give you a great introduction to the German language. 95% of our participants do not speak German on arrival, yet on average secure jobs and long-term apartments in Berlin within four weeks of arriving in the city as a result of our invaluable workshops on finding accommodation and English-speaking jobs.

# How to book



Once you are ready to book you can pay downpayment to secure a spot on the programme via our website. Payment for the programme can be made securely by PayPal.



Book your flight to arrive by the programme start date or a few days earlier.
